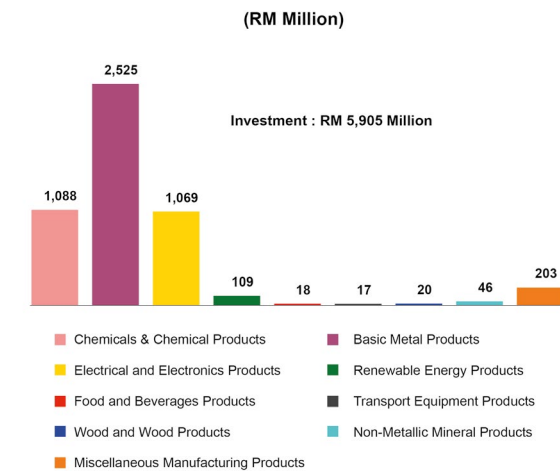

## SARAWAK : CAPITAL INVESTMENT IN MANUFACTURING PROJECTS, 2016



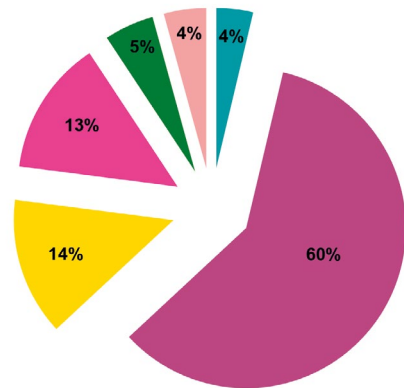

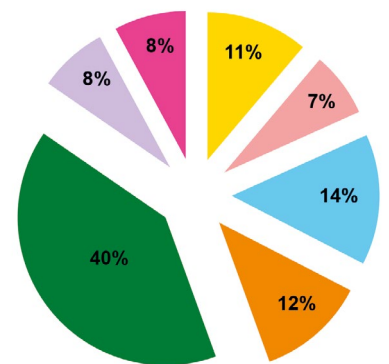
## SARAWAK : EXPORT BY COMMODITY SECTION, 2016

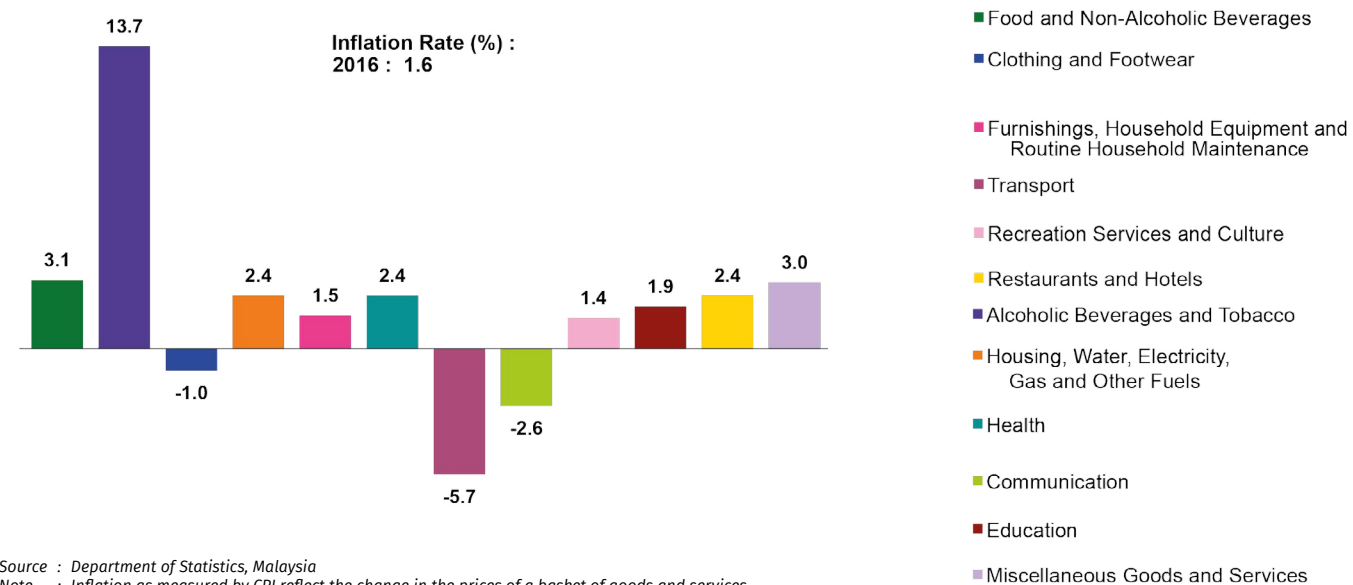
